- 2. I give permission to release all my information to potential host families.
- 3. I confirm that all information I have provided is honest, correct and complete.
- 4. After my confirmed placement I agree to stay in touch with the host family.
- 5. I will not travel to the family until all details are confirmed by the agency.
- 6. I understand that I need to arrange and pay for travel to/from my host country and insurance.
- 7. I ensure passport and driver's license are up to date, ready for travel and valid for the duration of stay.
- 8. I will respect the family agreement and house rules and will carry out my duties to my best ability.
- 9. I shall seek advice of the host family before using any form of discipline on the children and under no circumstances shall I hit the children or leave them alone.
- 10. I understand that the success of the au pair experience depends largely on my initiative and flexibility to adapt.
- 11. Within the first week of my placement, I will inform accepting agency of my contact details.
- 12. If I have any problems or questions which I cannot resolve with the host family, I shall contact the local agency for assistance.
- 13. I will make every effort to resolve any differences with my host family. If a solution is not found, I will give 14 days' notice and may apply for a new placement. During notice, duties and pay continue as normal unless by mutual agreement. I will inform the local agency of notice given.
- 14. If I request to be placed in a new family, I understand that this is down to the discretion of accepting agency and that I am not guaranteed a second placement.
- 15. I shall not hold the agency responsible for any losses, injury or damage
- 16. I understand that my au pair program can be terminated if I fail to abide by this agreement, if I breach contract with the family or if there is a case of misconduct. This includes (but is not limited to) lying and falsification of documents.
